

# West Highland Way Adventure

Strike out on to the West Highland way, a 'bucket list' experience in the stunning Scottish Highlands, a walking holiday that guides you through breathtaking scenery, navigating rugged coastlines, mountain landscapes and true Scottish wilderness

## What You'll Do

### Day 1

Milngavie to Drymen – We will depart Edinburgh/Glasgow before walking through forestry and farmland with a tasting stop at the Glengoyne Distillery, before arriving at the village of Drymen.

### Day 2

Drymen to Rowardennan – From Drymen the route takes us through more forestry before the first proper ascent of the week, Conic Hill which has wonderful views of Loch Lomond and then a steep descent to the lochside at Balmaha, from where we follow the shore paths northwards to the hotel at Rowardennan.

### Day 3

Rowardennan to Inverarnan – A whole day on the wild eastern shore of Loch Lomond before arriving at the Drover's Inn, one of Scotland's most atmospheric inns.

### Day 4

Inverarnan to Tyndrum – Walking through Glen Falloch and Strathfillan, we have reached the half way point to Fort William. The surroundings start to open up with views of the mountains.

### Day 5

Tyndrum to Kingshouse – We start off with a gentle but sustained ascent from Tyndrum where we get the classic view of Ben Dorain, before descending to the valley floor and easy trail to Bridge of Orchy. We then climb a small wooded hill overlooking Loch Tulla before crossing Rannoch Moor – the wildest part of the whole way.

### Day 6

Kingshouse to Kinlochleven – The highest point of the Way at nearly 600m/2000ft and known as the Devil's Staircase by the labourers who built the Blackwater Dam in 1909, this section has a fierce reputation but is in fact a pleasant day's walking with awesome views of the Glencoe Hills and the Mamores, before descending through woodland to the village of Kinlochleven.

### Day 7

Kinlochleven to Fort William – Our final day starts with a wooded ascent from Kinlochleven, before rejoining old military road which we follow over to Glen Nevis, with a view of Ben Nevis and descend into Fort William, where we finish off with a meal to celebrate before heading back to Edinburgh or Glasgow in the evening.
